Dear Parents of Class of 2017,

Thank you and your student for participating in Township High School District 211's One-to-One Program. The program has proven beneficial for equipping students with the tools and skills they will need to be successful in a digitally-connected world.

District 211 is providing your graduating senior the opportunity to purchase the iPad issued for use during the current school year. **Students will be purchasing their currently assigned device.** Purchase includes the device's cable, charging block, and the existing case. No replacement will be provided for lost or damaged accessories. Prices for specific iPad models are listed below.

1. iPad 4 – \$125.00
2. iPad Air – \$150.00

To be eligible to purchase an assigned iPad student must be in good standing relative to graduation requirements and all outstanding school obligations must be satisfied.

Payment for the iPad must be made in-full to the school's cashier no later than May 5, 2017. No payments will be accepted after **May 5, 2017.**

Upon purchasing the iPad, all District-bought apps and licenses will be staged for return to school district ownership. These apps and licenses will be removed from your student's iPad on May 24, 2017 or after completion of your student's last final exam, whichever is later. Information about backing-up iPads will be made available to students in advance of this date.


After an iPad has been purchased by the student, District 211 relinquishes responsibility for the iPad and its accessories, D211 iPad insurance coverage ends and technological support will no longer be provided through the school district.

Graduates who do not purchase their iPad will be required to turn in their device and all accessories no later than May 18, 2017. At that time, the school's technology department will review the physical status of the iPad, charging brick, USB cable, and case. The following chart provides details regarding the device evaluation and the replacement cost for specific items. Final costs for damages or replacement are dependent upon participation in the school district's optional iPad insurance program.
